Treasurer

President's report / discussion items

We will be looking to sell at other locations as well. Students are needed at these ticket sales events - they earn service hours. We only sold 5 or 6 tickets at the last football game and we sold about 30 tickets at the Cultural Fair. 2. Our next Dine Out Night is on October 18th at Organico. We get either 10% or 15% of the proceeds. Just mention Cherokee Bands.
3. We are in the process of planning the end-of-season Marching Band Banquet. Currently looking at either December 4 or December 11. A Sign Up Genius will go out for dessert donations. Members can bring two guests - cost is \$15 per adult and \$10 per child. There is no cost for Marching Band members.
4. Marching Band Middle School Night is this Friday, October 14th. It is open to current 7th and 8th graders interested in Marching Band. Middle School students should meet outside the band room at 4:30. They will play in the stands with the MArching Band and watch the halftime show from the track.
