Treasurer Report (Judeth/Terri)

- Judeth presented the proposed budget for the 2023-2024 school year. The format of the budget
 was changed to reflect more general line items for the different musical groups. Paul Lukianovich
 made a motion to approve the proposed budget and was seconded by Anthony Brancaccio. All in
 favor. Budget was passed.
- 2. A change was proposed for the current senior scholarships. Currently, all senior marching band members receive a scholarship \$50 for each year of marching band participation. The proposal is to create three larger scholarships one for marching band, one for wind band, and one for jazz band. This would require a committee and a By-Laws change. Beth Garofola, Patti Barber, and Lauren Hodges volunteered for the committee.

Marching Band Registration (Kathy Bradley)

- 1. Registration will open soon. Season fee for 2023 is \$375. This is in addition to the \$200 activity fee which goes to the district, not directly to the marching band.
- 2. First practice is Wednesday, July 28th, 5:30-8:30 PM. Practices will then be held leading up to band camp. Band camp will be held August 14-17, 9 AM 9 PM, and August 21-24, 9 AM 9 PM. Band camp is mandatory see Mr. Stowman with any concerns. There is a parent preview performance on the last night of band camp.
- 3. Members are also required to purchase marching shoes and warm-up jackets (can reuse from last year if they still fit). A suggestion was made to organize a shoe swap for members who have shoes that no longer fit.
- 4. Parents were given the opportunity to ask questions.
